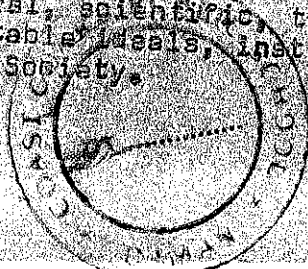
OBJECTS : The objects for which the Society is established
are as follows :

property, rights, assets and liabilities belonging

alter, extend, maintain, administer, manage,
schools, colleges, institutions for the diffusion
of useful knowledge, welfare centres, training
centres, dispensaries, clinics, hospitals,
rehabilitation centres, audio visual centres,
reading rooms, demonstration centres, model farms,
godowns, orphanages, boarding houses, hostels,
night shelter, homes for the aged, rescue homes,
contraternities and other educational, cultural,
scientific, technical, medical, agricultural,
charitable and related institutions, works,
activities and amenities in any part of India,
for all irrespective of religion, race, community,
caste, language or social status.

(c) To give subscriptions, contributions or assistance,
pecuniary or otherwise to charitable, educational,
ecclesiastical, technical, agricultural, medical,
benevolent welfare or other institutions, bodies,
persons as from time to time may deem necessary
or appropriate according to law.

(d) To print, publish, issue and exhibit any journals,
periodicals, books, papers, pamphlets, advertise-
ments, reports, lectures and other reading material
for the diffusion of useful knowledge and for the
promotion, benefit and advancement of the educational,
cultural, scientific, technical, agricultural and
charitable ideals, institutions, works and activities
of the Society.

RULES & REGULATIONS
OF
COAST GUARD AIR STATION DAMAN SOCIETY

1. INTERPRETATION : In these Rules and Regulations, under the context otherwise requires :

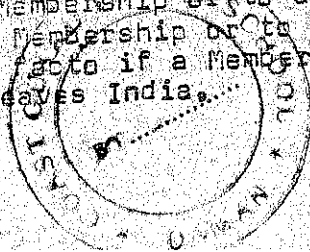
- (a) "The Society" shall mean Coast Guard Air Station Daman Society.
- (b) "Governing Body" shall mean the Governing Body of the Society as constituted and provided by these Rules and Regulations.
- (c) "The Act" shall mean the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 or any modification thereof for the time being in force.
- (d) Words importing the singular number shall be deemed to include the plural number and vice versa.

2. MEMBERSHIP : Any person of the age of majority who shall make the requisite application for the Membership of the Society may become a ordinary member of the Society on admission to membership by the Governing Body. The decision of the Governing Body by majority of votes to admit or reject any candidate for membership to the Society shall be final and conclusive, without the Governing Body being bound to give any reason for such decision. However, he/she have no voting powers in the Governing Body. The Governing Body empowered to grant admissions at their discretions to students. However, the total admissions in this category shall not exceed 10% of the total strength of the school in one session. The day to day management of the school shall be finalised by a management committee appointed by the Governing Board consisting the following :

3. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP : The Governing Body shall have the power at any time, by writing under the hand of the Chairman or such other member as the Governing Body may appoint on this behalf, without being bound to give any reason for such action, to terminate the membership of any ordinary member and on receipt of intimation of termination of membership, such member shall forthwith cease to be a Member of the Society and to have any right of claim whatsoever to any right or privilege of Membership or to any property of the Society. The Membership of the society also terminates de facto if a Member dies, resigns or permanently leaves India.

4. MEMBERSHIP AND MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION : Every Member of the Society shall be bound by the provisions of the Memorandum of Association of the Society and these Rules and Regulations and the decision from time to time taken by the Society in the General Meetings and the deliberations of the Governing Body.

5. PROPERTY AND INCOME : The property and income of the Society shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society as set forth in this Memorandum of Association, and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend or otherwise howsoever to the Members of the Society provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith or remuneration to any Officer or employees of the Society or to any member of the Society or other person for any services actually rendered.

6. GOVERNING BODY : The affairs of the Society shall be managed and administered by the Governing Body consisting of not less than several members and not more than five members. The Governing Body will consist of Chairman, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and two patron Members. However, the office of the Secretary and the Treasurer may be held jointly by one Member, should the Governing Body so decide.

The Governing Body will be at liberty from time to time to remove any ordinary Member not ex-officio of the Governing Body or any member of the Society by a resolution with majority of votes and on such resolution being passed, the Chairman shall forthwith terminate the membership of such member.

In the event of any vacancy arising among the Members of the Governing Body, by resignation, death or removal as provided herein, such vacancy shall be filled by the Chairman from among the Members of the Society within one month from the date of vacancy. The Governing Body may act notwithstanding any vacancy in its number.

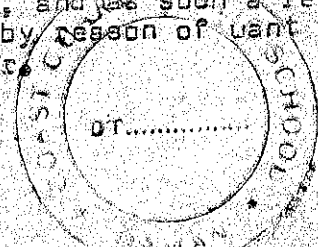
7. CHAIRMAN : The Chairman will always be the Commanding Officer, CGAS Daman and Meeting of the Society and of the Governing Body, and shall have a second or casting vote in case of any equality of votes at the Meeting.

The Chairman, or in his name, the Secretary of the Governing Board shall convene all Meetings of the Governing Body at such time and place as he may think fit.

8. QUORUM AT GOVERNING BODY MEETING : A Quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body shall be three members personally present.

9. CIRCULAR RESOLUTION : A Circular Resolution issued by the Chairman on any subject which he deemed urgent, and signed by a majority of the Members of the Governing Body, shall in all respects be as valid and binding as a resolution passed at the meeting of the General Body duly convened and constituted, and as such a resolution shall not be deemed invalid by reason of want of notice or any other cause whatsoever.

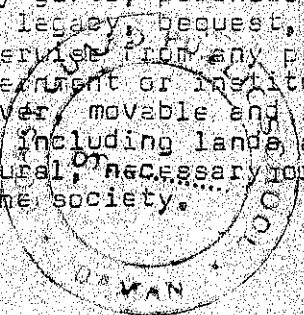
11. POWERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY : The Governing Body shall have the entire control and management of the business and affairs of the Society and shall have all such powers of the Society and so all as are, by the Act, not required to be exercised or done by the Society in a General Meeting.

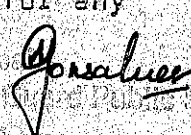
The Governing Body shall also have powers from time to time to make, vary and repeal rules and regulations for the transaction and regulation of the business and affairs of the Society, and itself.

Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers, the Governing Body shall have the following powers of the Society, namely :

- (i) to take over, endow, establish, conduct, maintain, manage, administer, carry on, develop, improve, alter schools, colleges, institutions for the diffusion of useful knowledge, welfare centres, training centres, dispensaries, clinics, hospitals, rehabilitation centres, clubs, guilds, audio-visual centres, reading rooms, demonstration centres, model farms, godowns, orphanages, boarding houses, hostels, night shelters, homes for the aged, rescue homes, confraternities and other educational, scientific, technical, medical, agricultural, sports, charitable and related institutions, works, amenities and activities of all kinds in any part of India,
- (ii) to acquire by gifts, purchase, lease, mortgage, loan, grant, legacy, bequest, exchange, privilege, right or otherwise from any person, company, society, government or institution or any other body whatsoever, movable and immovable properties, descriptions including lands agricultural or non-agricultural, necessary or useful for any purpose of the society.

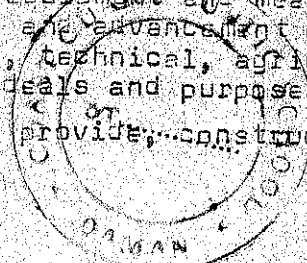

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- (iii) to construct, equip, purchase, endow, maintain and from time to time improve, modify, alter, reconstruct suitable sites, buildings, tenements, offices, structures, institutions, wells, farms, small industries, laboratories, amenities and facilities, deemed necessary or useful for any purpose or purposes of the Society.
 - (iv) to intimate, encourage, promise, organise, operate, advice marketing organisation, small industries, legal aid, societies, community services or other institutions, bodies, persons as from time to time and deem necessary or appropriate for any purpose or purposes of the society.
 - (v) to engage, employ and procure the assistance of and to suspend discharge and dismiss directors, managers, assistants, teachers, lawyers, technical advisors, doctors, nurses, clerks, secretaries, accountants, workmen, servant and other personal or staff either for remuneration or gratuitously and to pay them salaries, wages, gratuities, expenses, pensions, provident funds and any other remuneration for the services rendered to the Society.
 - (vi) to accept, receive, hold, administer and use any gift bequest, donation, subscription or foundation in cash or kind or any other form of property, whether subject to any trust or not for any of the objects of the Society.
 - (vii) to invest, lay aside, deposit in banks or otherwise deal with the moneys or funds of the Society not immediately required for the objects of the Society and to subscribe for, purchase, acquire, hold, sell, endorse and negotiate in every description on the money market.
 - (viii) to borrow and to raise funds with or without security in any manner the society may think fit and to repay the same.
 - (ix) to use the property and assets of the society and all income from the property and assets movable and immovable or from the works of the society as set forth in this Memorandum of Association PROVIDED THAT no portion thereof be distributed among its members by way of profits, dividends, bonuses, or by any other form except by remuneration for services rendered to the Society.
 - (x) to take over, correct, endow, develop, maintain, establish, conduct, equip, alter, improve, administer educational, charitable and medical buildings, hostels, workshops, training centres and other institutions, works, activities and amenities connected with the objects of the Society.
 - (xi) to acquire, provide, construct, organise, maintain, improve, alter and conduct premises, faculties, equipment and means for the propagation and advancement of the charitable educational, technical, agricultural and uplifting ideals and purposes of the society.

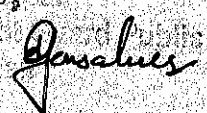

- (xiii) for any purpose aforesaid, to employ and procure the assistance of and to suspend, discharge and dismiss teachers, instructors, doctors, nurses, workers and other personnel or staff either for remuneration or gratuity and on such terms as the Governing Body may deem fit.
- (xiv) to apply for, collect, recover, receive and utilise any Government, Municipal or other grants or allowances in connection with any institution, activity, work or property held or conducted by the Society, or otherwise and to deal with the same according to the terms thereof.
- (xv) to conduct individuals, companies, firms, associations charitable trusts and the general public and inform them of the society, whether by personal visits, written appeals, or otherwise, as may be deemed expedient for the purposes of securing contributions to the Society funds.
- (xvi) to take, receive, hold administer and use any gifts, bequests, donations, endowments or foundations in kind or money or any other property whether subject to any trust or not for any of the objects of the Society and to undertake and carry out the offices, duties and functions of trustees, managers and administrators, whether solely or jointly with another or others for or in respect of any gifts, bequests, donations, endowments, trusts, foundations or property whether vested in the society or otherwise.
- (xvii) to open and operate on current, overdraft, saving or fixed deposit accounts with any Bank on such terms and in such manner as the Governing Body shall deem fit.
- (xviii) to print, publish, issue and exhibit any journals periodicals, books, papers, pamphlets, advertisements, reports, lectures and other reading matters for the diffusion of useful knowledge and for the promotion, benefit and advancement of the medical, sports, educational, cultural, scientific-technical, agricultural and charitable ideals, institutions, work and activities of the Society.
- (xix) To commence, prosecute, defend, appear to, conduct, continue, compromise, abandon, contest or subject to decree, order or judgement any civil, criminal, administrative, revenue, municipal arbitration, conciliation or other proceeding or inquiry for the furtherance or any or in conjunction with any of the objects or functions of the Society and to engage and remove experts, specialists, actuaries, doctors, lawyers, accountants, valuers, contractors, brokers, agents and other for any of the purposes of the Society on such terms as the Governing Body shall deem fit.

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(xx) Generally to do all such things as may be deemed by the Governing Body to be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

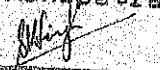
12. **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING :** The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held in the month of June or as near thereto as possible in each year, at such time and place as the Chairman may determine, for the following purpose :
- (a) to receive the report of the Governing Body, the accounts of the Society and its Auditors' Report for the year ending 31st March preceding the date of the meeting ;
 - (b) to appoint an Auditor or Auditors and fix his or their remuneration ; and
 - (c) to advise, suggest or recommend the Governing Body about the policies of the Society,
13. **EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING :** The Chairman of the Governing Board may call an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Society, whenever in their or his opinion, they or he may deem it necessary to do so at a notice of 7 days.
14. **QUORUM :** For all the General Meeting of the Society, the Quorum shall be two members personally present and the Chairman.
15. **VOTING :** At all meeting of the Society or of the Governing Body, every member present shall have one vote. Voting by proxy shall not be allowed. The Chairman shall preside and have a second or casting vote in the case of equality of votes.
16. **AMENDMENTS :** The Memorandum of Association of the Society and these Rules and Regulations and any Rules and Regulations hereinafter made by the Society, may from time to time be varied, added to or revoked by a majority of not less than three-fifths of the members of the Society present at a General Meeting called for the purpose of such variation, addition or revocation.

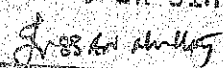

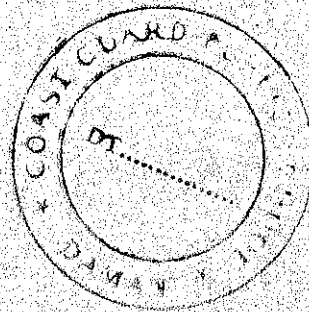

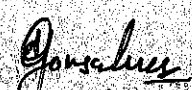
