Sub: Recognition Certificate for the School under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2009 for the purpose of Section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Sir,

With reference to your application dated 12/11/2018 and subsequent correspondence with the school in this regard, I am directed to convey the grant for recognition to the Coast Guard Public School, Dalwada Daman, for Class I to Class VIII under section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:

1. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2009 (Annexure II).
2. The school shall admit in class in 1 (or in pre-school class, as the case may be) to the extent of 25% of strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantage group in the neighbourhood and provide Free and Compulsory elementary education till its completion.
3. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of sub-section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall maintain a separate bank account.
4. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
5. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof, if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period provided prescribed for admission and on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
6. The School shall ensure:
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school;
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
 - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23;
 - (v) Inclusion of Students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the Act;
 - (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years;

(vii) The teacher performs its duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act and

(viii) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.

7. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
8. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-

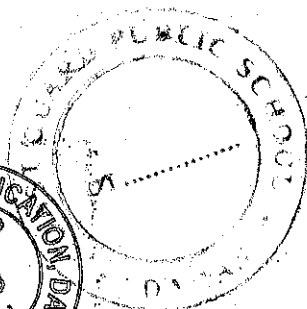
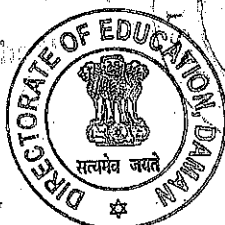

10. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes education and skill development.
11. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force;
12. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons;
13. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
14. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/ Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school;
15. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
16. Other conditions as per Annexure enclosed.
17. Administration shall always have the right to withdraw recognition /permission to school if it is not satisfied with academic or administrative management of the school.
